One of the joys of preparing an annual report is that it gives us the opportunity to look back and be thankful for all that has been accomplished. The past fiscal year was filled with wonderful opportunities. Some of the highlights were:

We were able to give grants and funding of \$311,795.27 in support of Central Peninsula Hospital its patients, residents and clients.

We gave out two \$2,000 college scholarships to high school seniors through the Dr. Isaak Memorial Scholarship fund, and we gave out four \$1,000 college scholarships to high school seniors through the CPGH, Inc. Auxiliary Healthcare Scholarship fund.
